Arc Herkimer's Marlowe Earns The Arc New York Scholarship

Jason Marlowe, Arc Herkimer assistant director of Compliance & Quality, is one of four recipients statewide of the Jonathan Weingold Scholarship, awarded from The Arc New York and given to those pursuing special education degrees.

There were more than 70 applications this year. The scholarship is presented annually to four full-time chapter employees who wish to further their education with the intention of contributing to the field of intellectual or developmental disabilities. The award, in the amount of \$3,000 per recipient, is paid in installments of \$1,500 for two semesters. Marlowe plans to utilize the scholarship while working on a Master's of Healthcare Administration degree.

The Arc New York is comprised of 52 chapters, including Arc Herkimer, which supports 60,000 individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families and caregivers statewide. The Arc New York's mission is to advocate and provide support and services to people with disabilities, emphasizing choice and community engagement.

The Arc New York was founded in 1949 to serve a critical mission—to improve the quality of life for people. What started as a support group and day nursery for families coping with these disabilities has grown to become the largest nonprofit in New York State serving those with developmental and other disabilities.
